Driving to our Lodge



# Our Location

LML is the best-situated mountain lodge in the Cordillera Blanca & Andes mountain range. Situated just 25 minutes walk from the entrance to the Huascarán National Park, we are in a privileged & unique location that no other lodge in the region can compete with.

The Cordillera Blanca boasts more than 50 peaks over 5700m, in comparison to just 3 situated in Central & North America. LML has been strategically situated, offering unrivaled trekking & views of the 3 largest peaks in the range. LML is a Labour of Love, in a world of extremes, against all odds. As such we are always working hard to improve our lodge to bring you the ultimate trekking experience.

## **Lima - Huaraz - Yungay**

If driving from Lima to Huaraz (5-6hrs), we strongly suggest using Googlemaps to give you a clear indication of the best route to leave Lima. Once outside of Lima, you will head north on the Panamericana Norte, passing Huaral & Huacho. Having gone past Barranca you will turn right & continue on the tarmac/asphalt road, that will take you directly to Huaraz.

From Huaraz continue on the motorway towards Carhuaz & after approximately 1hr you will arrive at the town of Yungay.

## **Yungay - Lodge**

From Yungay you have two routes to arrive at the lodge. Please bear in mind that there is no cell phone signal between Yungay and the lodge.

**Route 1:** Enter Yungay and pass the Plaza de Armas (main square) on your right hand side. As the road forks to your left, bear to the right & pass the Hospital de Apoyo on your right-hand side. At the end of the concrete road continue STRAIGHT onto a dirt road, with mud brick houses either side of you. This is the road to Carhuan, Chilca, Huarca & the Llanganuco valley. Pass through these villages & countryside until you arrive at the 16.6km junction to Llanganuco Mountain Lodge.

At this junction, turn left onto a dirt track with small pine trees either side. After 200m turn left, just before a 1m high standing stone on your left, keep straight on with the mountains now at your back, through a slight hollow and enter through the pine trees to our circular driveway.

**Route 2:** Enter Yungay & at the police station turn right heading up the hill. Continue on this road for approximately 30 mins. Then you will need to take the left fork between Km 18 & 19, then take the right fork on the curve between km 17 and 16 on the new road.



### PLEASE NOTE:

- If you are traveling between November - March, we advise that you use a 4x4 vehicle as the rain can make the dirt track muddy & slippery.
- There are no signposts to the lodge, as we pride ourselves on being hidden away so if you do get lost, remember to ask for directions to "Casa de Charlie" NOT Lianganuco Mountain Lodge.
- Please bear in mind that there is no cell phone signal on route.
- We STRONGLY recommend that you arrive by 5:30pm to enjoy the sunset. You must arrive before dark at 6pm, otherwise you are VERY unlikely to ever find us.
